“TRANSFORMING EDUCATION WITH SUPERINTENDENT BREWER” SHOW RECEIVES PRESTIGIOUS BRONZE TELLY AWARD FOR OUTSTANDING LOCAL PROGRAMMING

LOS ANGELES – Move over Oprah for the next talk show host of prime time – Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) Superintendent David L. Brewer III. He just received a bronze statuette, a Telly Award, for outstanding local programming for his hosting duties on KLCS-TV/DT.

“Transforming Education with Superintendent Brewer,” the live, weekly half-hour call-in interview program provides parents, teachers and community members with an opportunity to discuss timely issues impacting the District with the superintendent and district officials.

“The Telly Award truly validates the important public service that our program can provide to parents, students and other viewers who seek out unique programming that informs, educates and enlightens,” said Superintendent Brewer.

Brewer’s 30-minute show is broadcast live every Wednesday at 7 p.m. from KLCS-TV, the LAUSD’s television studios, in downtown Los Angeles.

This year’s competition received more than 14,000 entries from production agencies, TV stations, cable companies and corporations throughout the world. Submissions were judged by a panel of past Telly Award winners, who evaluated the entries against a high standard of merit rather than against each other.

Founded in 1979, the Telly Awards is the premier award honoring outstanding local, regional, and cable TV commercials and programs; the finest film and video productions, and groundbreaking web commercials, videos and films. Winners represent the best work of the most respected advertising agencies, production companies, television stations, cable operators, and corporate video departments in the world.
