Proactive Actions To Help Schools

### **TOP 10 IDEAS FOR SCHOOLS TO USE THE SWPBS DVD**

- #1...Have all members of your school's SWPBS Team watch the DVD.
- #2...Show the DVD at a staff meeting and have the SWPBS Team review how your school is implementing each of the 8 major components.
- #3...Have school staff watch a single section of the DVD that pertains to a specific major component to refresh everyone's commitment to implementing your school's SWPBS plan.
- #4...Show clips from the DVD to students during assemblies regarding SWPBS.
- #5...Have your school's School Site Council, English Learner Advisory Committee (ELAC), Compensatory Education Advisory Committee (CEAC) and other school committees watch the DVD to support understanding of the Discipline Foundation Policy and how your school is implementing your plan.
- #6...Review the DVD for ideas on how other schools in LAUSD are implementing SWPBS and go to the District's website <http://disciplinepolicy.lausd.net> for additional strategies regarding implementation.
- #7...Complete the Team Implementation Checklist (TIC) and include examples of how your school demonstrates each of the 8 major components. Then watch the DVD and compare your examples with those provided on the DVD.
- #8...Show the DVD to your school's community partners at a Resource Coordinating Council meeting, at local government meetings and as other opportunities arise to support understanding of the Discipline Foundation Policy and how it relates to them.
- #9...Make a presentation using the DVD to local volunteer organizations like Kiwanis, Rotary Club, and others to gather support for your school's SWPBS plan.
- #10...Have your school's technology SLC, PLE, classes or club watch the DVD and then create a similar DVD for your school that demonstrates how you are implementing the 8 major components of SWPBS.
