

Sample call to parents about Connect-ED phone calls

In an ongoing effort to improve student academic success, we will join schools across LAUSD in taking attendance electronically using the new Integrated Student Information System (ISIS).

Starting on [DATE], parents and guardians of students who are absent or tardy will receive two automated attendance calls a day. The first call is sent in the morning, based on the attendance information in the system by 9:30 a.m. The second call is sent in the evening, based on data in the system by 3:30 p.m.

Whenever your child is tardy or absent from school an automated attendance call will be made. For example, even if you call the school to inform staff that your child will be out ill, a call will be made to the telephone number you provided to the school for attendance notifications. Should you wish to change this number, please contact the school at [SCHOOL TELEPHONE NUMBER].

Please do not be alarmed if you receive a call about an absence, even though you dropped your child off at school. The Connect-ED system does not differentiate between absences and tardies, which is why it is important for your child to be in school, on time.
